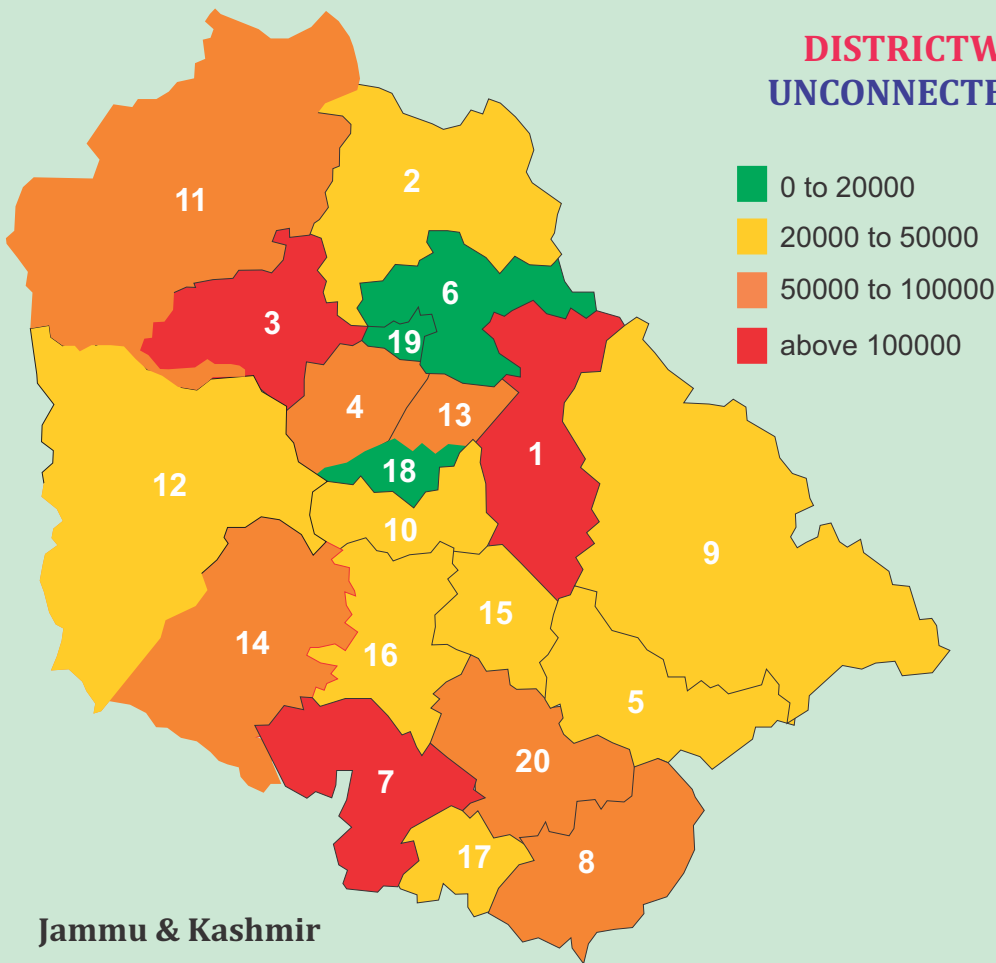

Vision

- ★ Every rural household to have drinking water supply in prescribed quantity and quality on regular and long-term basis at affordable service delivery charges leading to improvement in living standards of rural communities.



JAL JEEVAN MISSION

Jammu & Kashmir



Scope

- ★ Development of in-village piped water supply infrastructure to provide tap water connection to every rural household;
- H Development of reliable drinking water sources and/ or augmentation of existing sources to provide long-term sustainability of water supply system;
- H Wherever necessary, bulk water transfer, treatment plants and distribution network to cater to every rural household;
- H Technological interventions for removal of contaminants where water quality is an issue;
- H Retrofitting of completed and ongoing schemes to provide FHTCs at minimum service level of 55 lpcd;
- H Grey water management; Strategy for Planning and Implementation
- H Support activities, i.e. IEC, HRD, training, development of utilities, water quality laboratories, water quality testing & surveillance, R&D, knowledge centre, capacity building of communities, etc.; and
- H Any other unforeseen challenges/ issues emerging due to natural disasters/ calamities which affect the goal of FHTC to every household by 2021.
- H CPHEEO norms to be adopted for the design of water supply schemes with capacity to meet requirement upto next 30 years

Target **by Dec 2021**



- ★ All 10.65 Lacs unconnected Rural Households to be Connected with Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC).
- ★ Availability of assured supply of 55 LPCD of Clean Drinking Water meeting BIS 10500 standards to all Rural Households.
- ★ Assured upkeep and maintainance of water supply schemes for next 30 years.
- ★ 100% Grey Water Management.
- ★ Capacity building of stake holders.

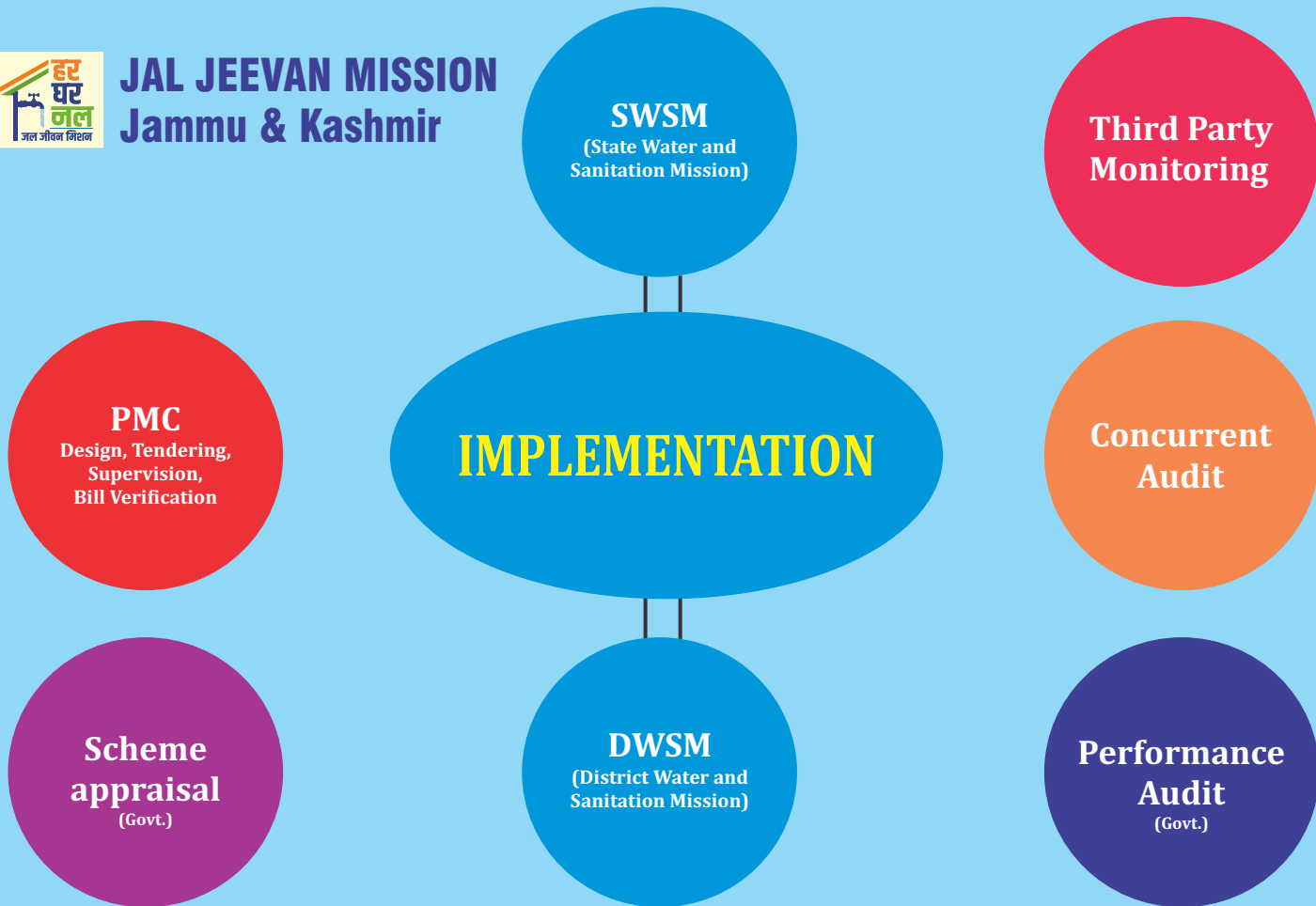
